Hi Everyone,

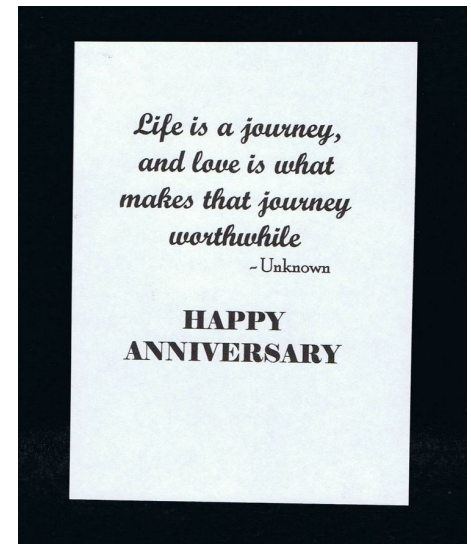
