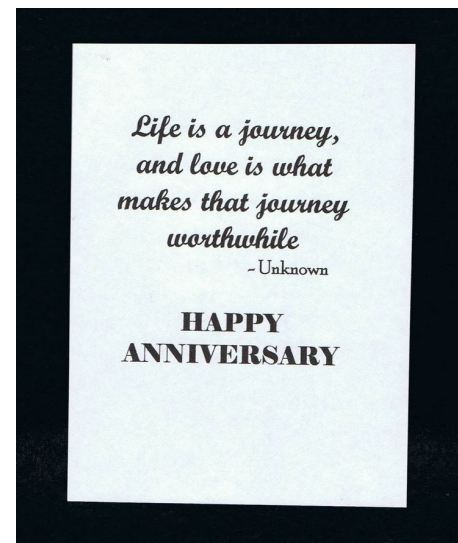
Hi Everyone,

I am always available to answer any questions or concerns regarding membership so call or email anytime

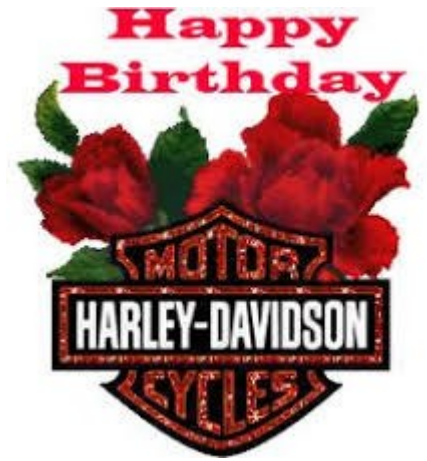

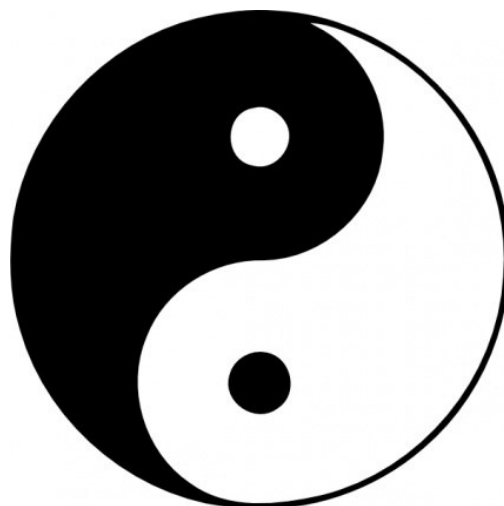
Thanks to Uke's for hosting the event and to Billy from the dealership for staying with us after hours!
