As a reminder both Full and Associate members need to be members of National HOG for them to join a local Dealer sponsored HOG Chapter

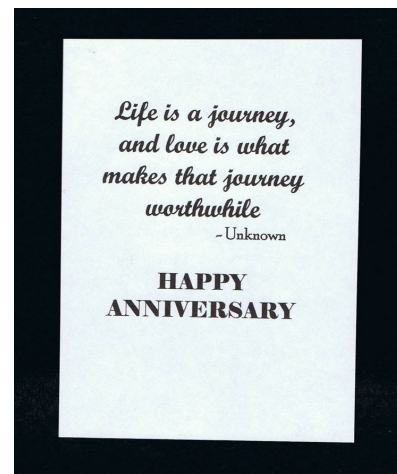

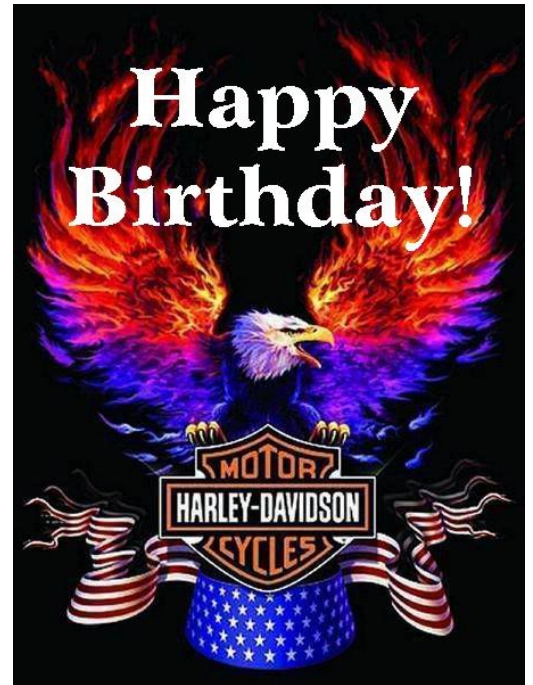

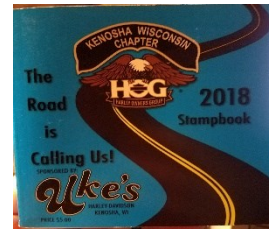
