Notes from the road, from Mr. Geraci....

TWO "ROAD DOGS" CELEBRATING

OZARK TWISTY AND MISSOURI SCENIC

We boys (Al P. and Joey G.) are on the loose. We are not "run-aways" but have permission. Our adventure is to explore NW Arkansas routes out of Harrison. From Chi to MO Rt.44 and south on Rt. 19 at Cuba began Ozark Nat'l Scenic Riverway Forest. Road surface conditions were excellent, except center line markings were absent as well as shoulders. Grass grew next to pavement. Motel 60 in Winona, MO had clean sheets, hot H2O and EL's Family Café adjacent for chow. Mark Twain Nat'l Forest offered fun and excitement as a "extreme" roller coaster route. Elevation changes of 10' to 25' (ups and downs) all in a row. The Holiday Inn Express in Harrison, AR was a 4-day base for the Ozark twisty.

The AR Motorcycle (MC) Riding Guide ('17) has 28 MC routes identified and color coded. Twelve routes start and return to Harrison: they total 1187 miles with 4635 scenic curves up, down and around the mountains of the Ozark Nat'l Forest. Other features included Buffalo Nat'l River and Bull Shoals Lake. At the Pell Ferry crossing of White River, we were told the flooding went to 40' above the water we rode the ferry over. Overlooking the AR Grand Canyon is the Cliff House where we enjoyed an awesome view and a delicious Elk burger. Rode scenic Rt. 7 to Conway to visit Toad Suck H-D and enjoyed the challenge of the Pig Tail on Rt 23. Departed Harrison on Rt. 65 N to Ozark, MO then East on 14. Found Rt. 21 N, Farmington and 67 N to Festus/S. St. Louis, at I-55. Our last night stop over for the final leg of our journey.

My rear tire went flat 130 miles from home. Called for a 26-mile tow to Chuck's H-D in Bloomington, IL; back on the road in 90 minutes. Entering I-294 from the I- 55 was a bit dicey. Behind schedule (in darkness) one felt like an ant trying to entering a herd of stamping elephants (18 wheelers). Home safely about 7:30 PM. See below NW AR route map of adventure and fun. The adventure may be over but the memories linger on. The people, places, mountains, roads and experiences are treasured memories. A great riding buddy (Al P), the 120K mile trucker who suggested we do the Canadian Rockies soon; the Louisiana men who were amazed at our mileage(s). The waitress whose father-in-law owned the place and soon would be the bookkeeper. Hunters Restaurant (owned by a beef baron rancher) where the lunch catfish was delightfully light: no specials this day because 16 oz. prime rib was being served that night at \$23.95 with salad bar and one side. The brother/sister (8 -10 yrs. old) team who rode their "soap box" car down the gravel road/driveway after pushing it up the hill (many times).

Yes, we did have a "slackers' day" only doing 261 miles and perhaps only a couple hundred curves. Total curves accomplished on this trip is estimated at 2500 (out of 4635 available). However, all these riding adventures was done in beautiful (mid 80's temps) warm sunny conditions except in Conway, AR (98 degrees). Most motorcyclists dream of fun filled days of riding curves after curves. NW AR has the roads to fulfill that dream that became a reality day after day on this trip. My Adventurous "side" lives on.
