Hi all!

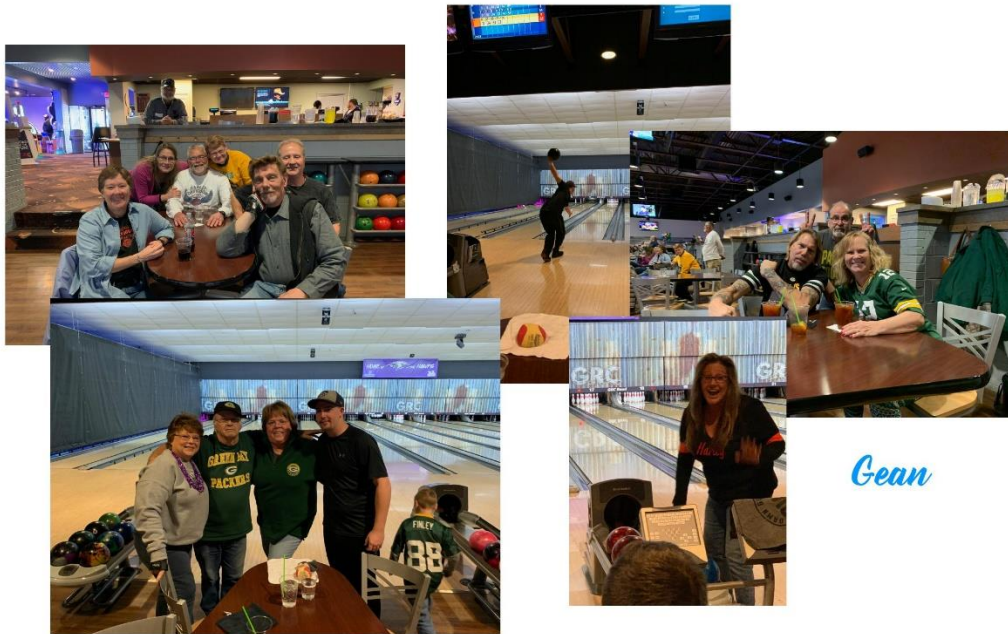

The 12 designs will also go out in an email and she will also be posting them on the chapter Facebook page for viewing.
